Silky dogwood (*Cornus amomum*)  
Gray dogwood (*Cornus racemosa*)  
Red or yellow twig dogwood (*Cornus sericea*)  
Cotoneaster (*Cotoneaster spp.*)  
Fuzzy deutzia (*Deutzia scabra*)  
Enkianthus (*Enkianthus campanulatus*)  
Burning bush (*Euonymus alatus*)  
Forsythia (*Forsythia x intermedia*)  
Fothergilla (*Fothergilla major*)  
Chinese witchhazel (*Hamamelis x intermedia*)  
Rose of Sharon (*Hibiscus syriacus*)  
Possumhaw (*Ilex decidua*)  
Winterberry (*Ilex verticillata*)  
Privet (*Ligustrum spp.*)  
Honeysuckle (*Lonicera spp.*)

Hardy camellias (*Camellia x spp.*)  
Plum yew (*Cephalotaxus harringtonia*) ‘Fastigiata’  
Hinoki cypress (*Chamaecyparis obtusa*)  
Japanese falsecypress (*Chamaecyparis pisifera*)  
Japanese holly (*Ilex crenata*)  
Dwarf Burford holly (*Ilex cornuta*)  
Inkberry (*Ilex glabra*)  
Skip laurel (*Prunus laurocerasus* ‘Schipkaensis’)  
Yew (*Taxus spp.*)- upright or fastigate forms  
Eastern arborvitae (*Thuja spp.*)- globe forms  
Lantanaphyllum viburnum (*Viburnum x rhytidophyloides*)- “10- month evergreen”  
Leatherleaf viburnum (*Viburnum rhytidophyllum*)  
Prague viburnum (*Viburnum x pragense*)

## **Deciduous (20 to 70 feet)**

Hedge maple (*Acer campestre*)  
Norway maple (*A. platanoides*)- upright forms  
Red maple (*Acer rubrum*) –upright forms  
Sugar maple (*A. saccharum*)- upright forms  
European hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*) var. ‘Fastigiata’  
Ginkgo (*Ginkgo biloba*)- upright forms  
‘Arnold’ tulip poplar (*Liriodendron tulipifera*) –upright form  
‘Slender Silhouette’ sweetgum (*Liquidambar straciflua*) –upright form  
Dawn redwood (*Metasequoia glyptostroboides*)  
Bald cypress (*Taxodium distichum*)

## **Evergreen (20 to 70 feet)**

White fir (*Abies concolor*)  
Atlas cedar (*Cedrus atlantica*)  
Deodara cedar (*Cedrus deodara*)  
Cedar of Lebanon (*Cedrus libani*)  
Atlantic white cedar (*Chamaecyparis thyoides*)  
Japanese cedar (*Cryptomeria japonica*)  
Arizona Cypress (*Cupressus macrocarpa*)  
Leyland cypress (x *Cupressocyparis leylandii*)  
Foster holly (*Ilex x attenuata* ‘Foster #2’)  
Burford holly (*Ilex cornuta*)  
American holly (*Ilex opaca*)  
Nellie R. Stevens holly (*Ilex x ‘Nellie R. Stevens’*)  
Chinese juniper (*Juniperus chinensis*) - columnar forms  
Red cedar (*Juniperus virginiana*)  
Spruces (*Picea spp.*)  
Pines (*Pinus spp.*)  
Eastern arborvitae (*Thuja occidentalis*)- columnar forms  
Douglas fir (*Pseudotsuga menziesii*)  
Western arborvitae (*Thuja plicata*) –include ‘Green Giant’  
Canadian Hemlock (*Tsuga canadensis*)  
Carolina hemlock (*Tsuga caroliniana*)
